

The aim of the Para Academy programme is to develop the training and education of BD Para riders along a defined pathway towards the Podium Potential Pathway programmes. Para Academies will comprise of two 2-day camps. In order to accept a place as a Para Academy Athlete, riders **must be able to** commit to attending both camp dates at the location/s below.

### **Para Academy Criteria**

- Have not been on any BEF World Class programmes (P3, P2, P1) in the last 4 years.
- Have not competed at a CPEDI3\* in the last 4 years.
- Combinations to submit their best 3 affiliated competition results from 31 July 2023 1 August 2024.
- Results should be from a minimum of two different venues and two different judges, with a minimum percentage of 60% gained in both results.
- Results can be gained in any of the para sections/ qualifier tests within the bronze, silver, and gold BD Para format.
- Results can be gained in a 1 and or 2\* CPEDI.
- There is no age limit for applicants.
- Combinations will be selected by the BD Para Technical Committee following references from Development Officers/Regional Para Representatives.
- Successful applicants will be contacted by week commencing 15 August 2024 by the BD Para International Officer.



#### **Terms and Conditions**

- Full payment of £280 per 2-day camp will be due 28 days prior to the date of each camp. (This is inclusive of costs for training, stabling and rider catering).
- Cancellations received no less than 14 days prior to a Camp will be refunded minus a 10% admin fee.
- Cancellations made less than 14 days prior to a camp are non-refundable/transferrable unless the place can be filled, in which case a full refund (less a 10% admin fee) may be given.
- Amendments to bookings in the 7 days prior to the event are non-refundable and changes are subject to the organisers' discretion.
- Riders who are accepted onto the programme and subsequently change horses between the point
  of application and the first camp, for reasons such as injury, may be permitted to attend the camps
  with the alternative horse following assessment of individual circumstances. Combination changes
  will be subject to the alternative horse demonstrating an ability to achieve the minimum performance
  criteria. Decisions will be at the discretion of the BD Para Technical Committee and priority will be
  given to combinations already achieving minimum performance criteria.
