### **Overall Placings for the Inter Regional Competition**

- Placings for the TEAM competition will be made by adding the top 3 percentages for each team in the TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP
- Placings for the INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP will be made by adding the percentages in the TEAM and INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP for individual riders (Class 2a & Class 2b). There will be an overall Individual Champion from all grades competing and placings will follow accordingly
- A special prize will be awarded to the rider achieving the highest % increase in marks from Day 1 to Day 2 in the Individual and Team Competitions for the Inter Regional and International Riders.

### **Special Prizes**

- A special prize will be awarded to the rider who gains the highest % increase in their test from competition day 1 to day 2. This will be split into two sections, one for Inter Regional Riders and one for International Riders.
- Team prizes will be awarded after from 1 – 6<sup>th</sup> place
- Individual prizes will be awarded from 1 – 6<sup>th</sup> place

### **CPEDIJ1\* Warm Up**

The sections shown as international classes are for riders wishing to compete at the CPEDIJ1\* which commences on the Friday 23 July 2010.

**Entry Fee:** The entry fee for the BEF and BD Inter Regional competition is £275 per competitor this includes dinner, bed and breakfast for the competitor and all entertainment, feedback. Stabling is extra. International Competitors may enter all eligible tests for the two days and pay the £275 entry fee to include the accommodation package, however, horse hire and stable fees are extra, additional warm up classes are also in addition.

Entry fees for individual classes are as shown

### **Conditions of Entry – National Competition and Inter Regional**

- Riders must be current members of the B.E.F Foundation Programme to be eligible for the BD & BEF Team Competition
- Riders for the BD Para Inter Regional must not be part of any BEF World Class Programme.
- Overseas riders may enter the classes which do not form a part of the Inter Regional Competition
- National riders may enter the classes which do not form part of the Inter Regionals.
- No rider may do more than 2 tests per day
- Horses must be 5 years or over.
- Riders must be eligible to compete in accordance with BD rules in the correct rider Grade as defined by their National or International Classification.
- No grading points will be awarded for this competition.

**Teams to consist of four riders from at least two different Grades.** Each rider must ride the Grade which they are eligible for, on a horse which is eligible for that level under British Dressage rules.

### **Classification**

It will not be possible to be classified at this event, however, classifiers are arriving on 22<sup>nd</sup> for CPEDIJ1\* and international classification opportunities will then be available.

**Venue:** Millfield School, Millfield, Somerset. See [www.millfieldenterprises.com](http://www.millfieldenterprises.com)

**Facilities:** The team competitions are residential competitions. The entry fee includes the price of dinner, bed and breakfast for the competitor for Friday and Saturday nights. Additional accommodation may be booked for additional nights and/or additional support staff/carers and family. However rooms are limited. No rooms have private facilities and are in the school boarding houses. All bed linen is provided, however, towels are not provided. It is also recommended that you may wish to bring an additional pillow!

ANY ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION MUST BE BOOKED WITH RIDERS ENTRY

**Stabling:** All stabling is on site. Horses competing in the International Competition will only be accepted between the following times as a Vet must be on site to inspect horses prior to unloading from transport.

Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> 1300 – 1800 & Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> 0900 – 1100.

On arrival at the stables you must not unload your horse until it has been inspected by the Vet and your passport presented to the organiser/stable manager. The price of the stables include bedding - shavings. It is compulsory to stable on site if competing in the Inter Regional Team Competitions and International Competition.

**Hook Up:** There are no electric hook up facilities on site. You are not permitted to sleep on site in your lorry overnight.

**General Rules:** Normal BD Championship rules apply. No whips or commanders are permitted in either the warm up test or the team test unless otherwise stated on the rider's classification card. Grading points will not be awarded. Riders must be eligible to ride at the level which they intend to compete in accordance with the rules above.

#### **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON SITE**

**Passports:** Horse passports must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipes to the Secretary's office on arrival.. Please note that the Secretary will only deal with Chef d'Equipes and if your Chef is going to be late, then a nominated person must make themselves known to the Secretary on arrival.. Official information will only be given to Chef d'Equipes or their nominated person. Please remember that if your horse is staying to do the International, all vaccinations must be in line with the FEI 6 monthly vaccination rule.

#### **Arena Walk:**

Competitors may walk in all competition arenas only at allocated times. Times will be posted on the notice board. Hard hats and suitable clothing must be worn while riding in the arena walk and horses are only permitted to walk around the exterior of the arenas.

Warm up and schooling of horses MUST be in accordance with BD Para Equestrian and FEI Rules.

#### **Entertainment:**

On Saturday evening, ALL International competitors will be given the opportunity to discuss their score sheets and comments with the judges.

There will be a cook-your-own BBQ in a nominated boarding house on Friday Night followed by disco.

## Appendix to Schedule

### 1 ACCOMMODATION

#### 1.1 Accommodation

All accommodation will be on-site at the competition venue – **Millfield School**

Requests for accommodation must be sent with FINAL entries.

Some single rooms with en-suite facilities are available

Each room has access to a bathroom but en-suite facilities are not available.  
Accommodation will be allocated by the OC according to disability requirements

#### 1.2 Meals

Depending on time of arrival/departure, Bed, breakfast and evening meal from 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2010 to 25<sup>th</sup> July 2010 is included in entry fee for one competitor per entry (ie two (2) nights).

#### 1.3 Accommodation Fee

The cost of accommodation for grooms, carers, trainers etc is £55 pppn

Additional nights (eg Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2010) will be charged at **£55** per person per night for dinner, bed and breakfast if required by competitors.

## 2 HORSES

### 2.1 Visiting Horses

Horses must arrive between 1300 – 1800 on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2010. Passports must be presented to the organiser on arrival, prior to unloading your horse. Your stable will be pre allocated before arrival so any 'special' requirements will only be accommodated if pre advised.

### 2.2 Stables

Permanent individual stabling available at the venue, and additional temporary stabling will be erected if required.

Stables will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Stabling will be provided on a DIY basis at a cost of **£25** per night to include bedding (shavings)

Haylage and forage may be obtained at the venue for the duration of the competition.

All horses must vacate the stables immediately after the competition finishes on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July

### 2.3 Hired Horses

An extensive database of horses from private homes and Millfield School is now available via the OC. Horses may be hired via the OC from Millfield are at **£35** per day (single rider) or £40 for a shared horse (maximum of two competitors may share the same horse. However, costs may vary if horses chosen are not owned at Millfield and these arrangements must be made directly with the horse owner. However, Millfield OC are happy to provide a contact list of available horses.

### 2.4 Horse Identification / Vaccination

**Hired / UK sourced horses are required to hold an identification card with a Flu Vaccination record to current FEI standards (ie six (6) monthly boosters from 1.1.06)**

NO HORSES WILL BE PERMITTED ON SITE WITHOUT A CURRENT VACCINATION CERTIFICATE. FOR THE INTER REGIONAL COMPETITION THIS VACCINATION NEEDS TO BE IN LINE WITH BRITISH DRESSAGE CURRENT RULES, FOR INTERNATIONAL HORSES, THIS MUST BE IN LINE WITH FEI CURRENT RULES.

## 3 TRANSPORTATION

As accommodation is available on-site, no local transportation is provided by the OC.

Full details of how to find Millfield can be obtained by visiting the website shown above.

Accommodation details will be issued by the Organiser on arrival.

Return transport may be facilitated on your behalf to either Bristol Airport, Taunton Railway station or Castle Cary Railway station (nearest).
