NORTHERN JUDGES

How do I become a judge? You need to become a trainee first before applying for your exam to go onto the Judges Panel. Details can be sent to you from head office by contacting Katrina Smith on katrinasmith@britishdressage.co.uk

How do I book onto judge training? Do I need to be a judge/trainee to take part? Judge training is primarily open to judges and trainees. At the discretion of the course taker on each specific date non BD judges/trainees may participate in the training. Seminars are only open to BD listed judges/trainees. If spaces allow and you are interested in attending a specific day please contact the organisers of the training. Please ensure you send an application form which can be found on the BD regional page (sometimes just a cheque is received with no note or details!) with separate cheques for **each session** you book onto. Applications close **7 days in advance of the training date.**

Attending training in another region – is this OK? Yes! Sometimes training in another region is closer to you or more convenient – just apply to the relevant RDO/Judges rep. as above.

If judge training is running at a competition day when will I receive times? Please include your email address and telephone number on your application form so you can be contacted. Once the times have been received from the organiser and the times are approved by the judge trainer they will be sent to all applicants at least 2/3 days in advance.
