

Riding Clinic with Ferdi Eilberg

Friday Saturday 9-10 March 2012 at Brickhouse Farm



The Eilberg's, an incredible success story!

Ferdie is a professional dressage trainer and rider from Germany, where he worked with Dr Reiner Klimke and was awarded the Reiter Abzeichnung, a gold medal for success in show jumping and dressage at advanced level. He has been resident in England since 1980 and has ridden for the British dressage team many times, winning team silver in the 1993 European Championships on Arun Tor and being listed for the 1996 Olympics.

Ferdie was dressage trainer to the British eventing team from 1982-92 and teaches Mary King. He was appointed director of coaching to the British dressage team in 2002 and Performance Manager in 2003, the year the team won its first European medal, bronze, for 10 years. Ferdie is currently working as part of the staff who is managing the World Class Equine Pathway. He has ridden for Great Britain twice at both the European Championships (1993 and 1995) and the World Equestrian Games (1994 and 1998). He was also the dressage trainer to the British Three Day Event Team from 1981-1992, accompanying them to three Olympic Games. In 2003 he became the second person to be granted an honorary Fellowship by The British Horse Society in recognition of his services to horsemanship.

In 2011 Ferdie's children topped the medal table of the British Dressage National Championships; Michael and Farouche were 5 year old Supreme Champions, but he also was Prix Saint Georges, Inter I Champion and Inter I Supreme Champion. Maria was Inter I Freestyle Champion. Wow, quite remarkable!

There will be several horses working at Grand Prix level but also young or Novice level horses. Ferdie is very meticulous on basic training and is very happy to work with horses of any level. Sessions will be of 45 min each and run between 9:30 and 16:30 approximately with a lunch break from 12:45 to 13:45 (exact timings will be confirmed by return of spectator's tickets).

Spectators' tickets: A limited number available and only pre-paid in advance on a first come first served basis. Hot drinks will be provided with the spectators tickets. Cost: £20 (non-refundable; please apply by email first to check availability and **only** then post your payment made out to Assouline Dressage along with your current email address for your e-ticket).

Riders: Payable in advance before 10 February at £95 per 45 min session. Limited stabling! Book with session: £35 per day.
