We would like to invite you to send teams to our Eastern Region young riders dressage competition. The competition is open to Eastern Region schools, Pony Clubs, Riding Clubs and all British Young Riders Dressage Scheme (BYRDS) members.

Class 1 - Preliminary 15 (Round 1)

Class 2 - Preliminary 13 (Round 2)

Class 3 - Novice 24 (Round 1)

Class 4 - Novice 37 (Round 2)

Class 5 - Elementary 42 (Round 1)

Class 6 - Elementary 45 (Round 2)

Class 7 - Medium 75

Class 8 - Advanced Medium 98

Class 9 - FEI Pick a Test Pony, Junior or Young Rider Individual Tests

Class 10 - Fledgling Rider Test 1 (2005) Open to riders 11 years and under

Class 11 - C Squad Rider Test 1 (2010) Open to C squad riders

Class 12 - B Squad Rider Test 2 (2010) Open to B squad riders

Class 13 - A Squad Rider Test 1 (2010) Open to A Squad riders

RULES

- All classes will be run as individual competitions, with rosettes and prizes offered accordingly. In addition to this, classes 1-6 will be used for the Team Competition. If you are riding in a team, you will automatically be eligible for individual placings too, so you don't need to enter the same test twice!
- If your horse/pony has competed in British Dressage affiliated competitions then you may only compete at the correct level or above for your horse/pony's points as at the closing date of entries.
- If your horse/pony does not have British Dressage points from affiliated competitions then you may compete at any level.

- Close of entries is **1 May 2012**.
- Test sheets for all the above classes can be obtained from British Dressage either via the website or by 'phoning the office on 02476 698830. (If you are buying the FEI tests online, from the drop down list choose "Under 21 tests". For the Squad Tests, choose "Rider Tests" drop down).
- .Rosettes & prizes in all classes.
- The competition will run under British Dressage Rules.
- Each class costs £12 to enter (That will be £24 for a team rider entry). Cheques payable to British Dressage.
- Times will be posted on the Eastern Regional webpage on Thursday 10th May (www.britishdressage.co.uk/your_regions/eastern_region) and on the Norton Heath website.
- Day stables are available at Norton Heath. If you would like to book one, please contact Norton Heath on 01277 824860.

THE TEAM CHALLENGE

- Teams to consist of 4 riders riding at either Preliminary, Novice or Elementary level.
- No more than 2 team members to compete at the same level. (ie your team can be made up of 2 x prelim and 2 x novice riders, or 1 x prelim, 1 x novice, 2 x elementary etc). Both tests at the level to be ridden by the relevant riders. Also, although it is desirable to have four team members so that you can have a discard score, you are very welcome to enter a team of three, it just means all scores will count on both rounds.
- Teams can be made up from the same school, yard, Riding Club, Pony Club, or with three other friends – so do come along and have a go!
- The team results will be determined by adding together the highest three placings from the first round, to the highest three from the second round. The team with the best overall mark at the end will be the winners.
- There will be individual Preliminary, Novice and Elementary Champions - to determine these awards the rider's percentages in the two rounds will be added together and the rider with the overall highest score will be the winner.
