



Executive Summary

Judges' Technical Committee Meeting

Date of Meeting: 30 April 2018

1. In the (January 2018) Minutes, Jane Critchley's name was missed off the attendees. There was a typo in the minutes on item 10, it should have read retired not returned. It was agreed to put a timescale on the action list.
2. A discussion took place on the Terms of Reference.
3. Discussion on GDPR took place.
4. Live stream training has taken place for the judges in Scotland at Hartpury and Myerscough. Sessions were all fully booked and judges appreciated this opportunity. Click meeting was the webinar that was used and it worked well, the only issues were around connection.
5. Discussion about the Winter Championships took place, points raised will go forward to the wash up meeting. In 2019, we will only have one FEI judge from Europe.
6. A discussion took place around complaints and the procedure. Sanctions will be placed in the complaints policy and sent to the Board for ratification.
7. Paras were discussed. A leaflet for Para's was given to everyone at the Judges' Convention. This leaflet will also be distributed to RDO's.
8. Payment of judges is under review via a working party.
9. Criteria for Examiners and Tutor Judges reviewed - looking in to implementing external quality assurance policy in line with UKCC to ensure robustness. The exam results were discussed, overall pass rates were: Part 1 - 84.2%, Part 2 - 69% and Part 3 - 57%. Novice 65 candidates 55%, Elementary 21 candidates 85%, Medium 21 candidates 47%, Ad Medium 16 candidates 43%. Results from June Parts 1 and 2 will be posted to candidates on 25th June, e mail confirmation will not be given.
10. The online music written papers has been taken and passed by 24 judges.
11. Part 1 written papers, music questions will no longer be included in the FEI levels.
12. Programme for Principles Seminar 6/7 October 2018 agreed – details will be e mailed to all members and it will go on the website.
13. National Judges' Convention will take place at 9th April 2019 at Addington Manor, details to follow.

14. Olympia 2018 we will be running a Seminar for National Judges on Tuesday 18th December. Details to follow.
15. Mentoring that was piloted nationally will continue regionally but not in such a structured format.
16. Criteria for Regional and Championship judges to be published in the Spring Newsletter.
17. Judges' Handbook written by Linda Whetstone will go live on 1 December in line with the Rule Book.
18. In 2019, FEI exams will take place at Somerford and Wellington.
