



Executive Summary

BD Youth Technical Committee Meeting

Date of Meeting: 24 January 2019

1. The Safeguarding reporting form is now available.
2. Committee to update and sign Conflict of Interest forms.
3. No Welfare issues had been reported.
4. Both the Foundation and National Academies were discussed and a wash up meeting is to be arranged to review and evaluate for 2019.
5. The National Academy programme is now finalised with Spencer Wilton as coach, Charlie Hutton as youth mentor (to provide a link up between the Academies and BEF Talent Pathways), Andy Thomas as physio, Liz Walsh to provide competition horse management, Avansce is sponsoring and will provide rein analysis.
6. Georgie Wheeler from BEF updated the committee on the Young Professionals' Programme. It was agreed that the programme required a wider spread when publicised to include young adults as well as BD Youth members.
7. Horse Care Test Development syllabus was agreed. Some content will be delivered and assessed on line and some practical assessments will be required.
8. Youth Assessor Coach Development - workforce orientation day arranged and the development programme to be rolled out regionally from March 2019.
9. More collaboration between BD Youth and U21 International pathways was discussed at length, to enable a clearer route to be identified by our members.
