Training Technical Committee Meeting

17 September 2019

1. No apologies - the committee welcomed Nadine Murray as the new RDO representative.
2. No Safeguarding issues reported.
3. No new Conflict of Interests reported.
4. No welfare issues reported.
5. Minutes of the last meeting – action points reviewed.
6. National Convention - planning is well underway and ticket sales are up when compared to the same time last year.
7. Young Horse Forums for 2020 were discussed, with the inclusion of a vet to the format.
8. A proposed coach CPD model was discussed focusing on outcomes rather than points or hours.
9. The regional training policies will be reviewed to ensure they still meet the needs of the regions.
10. BD Youth updates: The National and Foundation Academies are progressing well with the final National Academy day at Talland being very popular. The first Foundation Academy weekend is at Field house on 5 and 6 October. DiSE is now underway, AASE will be beginning in October.
