Major International Shows

Championship selection will be based on FEI Team and/or Individual test results from the major international spring shows that run a CDICH and/or CDIOCH as listed below:

8-12 April	CDIJYPCH Sint Truiden
30 April-2 May	CDIOJYPCH Saumur (CDIOCH Team only section)
13-17 May	CDIJYPCH Budapest
9-14 June	CDIOJYPCH/CDIJYPCH Hagen, Germany
11-14 June	CDIJYPCH Exloo

Riders who wish to be considered for selection for the EU-CH-COH will be expected to compete at a minimum of one CDI abroad, achieving scores of 69% and above on a minimum of two occasions. Scores gained in both Team and Individual tests ridden at the same competition will be considered. If a rider does not achieve this on their first trip abroad, they will be expected to gain a score at this level at a future competition abroad in order to be eligible for selection. Due consideration will be given to recent scores and an upward trajectory, providing the minimum requirement of 69% has been met.

As Premier League shows do not run Elementary classes, combinations need to produce three test sheets gained nationally in order to be eligible for international selection, all of which should be at a minimum of 69% or above. At least one of these tests should be recorded and a copy of the video sent to Selectors (see 5.4.2 of the Selection Policy).

Rules

All combinations will need to comply with the relevant FEI qualifications regarding age and experience for the 2020 competitive year. For European selection consideration, snaffle bridles must be worn in qualification. No whips can be used in any qualifying score tests.
