



Senior North & East Region Rider Test League 2021

The league is intended as a friendly competition for Bronze and Silver Riders in the region and there will be an overall winner for each level and placings down to 10th. The prize giving will be at the presentation ball in January 2020 with premium rosettes at each level.

Levels (PYO)

- Preliminary
- Novice
- Elementary
- Medium
- Advanced Medium
- FEI Levels

What to enter?

- Ride a test in training at the level you are eligible Bronze or Silver as a combination

What to do?

- Ride your test at any BD official training (flexi or a training/camp day) within the Northern region that is able to facilitate an arena with a regional Youth coach assessor on the Flexi Training list.
- The score sheet is different with marks for skills with an emphasis on your riding, influence on way of going and presentation of the test. Senior Score Sheets will be lilac 😊
- To qualify for the league you must be a member and resident in the region.
- To compete you submit your score sheet by email to jo.byrne@britishdressage.co.uk as a scanned or photographed copy of your score sheet.
- All tests to be considered must be submitted by 31 December 2021

Who wins?

- Riders across the levels achieving the most points between the 1 April and 31 December 2021. Levels will be split if numbers are sufficient
- Only your best 3 scores will count
- Riders submitting fewer than three sheets will not be placed without a Committee decision
- Winners will be notified and the awards will take place at the Northern Presentation Ball on 22 January 2022

Eligibility & Rules

- Riders must be eligible to ride at the level they wish to be ranked but may be any section other than Gold at that level.
- At least 2 of the tests to count must be marked by a different coach
- Riders must be a minimum of a Club Members on a BD Registered or Club horse or pony
