BD Youth

Squads and Regional Training



Whether you're training or competing with BD Youth you can work your way through our amazing squad system. You can train and compete with your squad at Regional camps and competitions!

Riders will enter at D Squad (until the end of the calendar year of their 11th birthday), C Squad (until the end of the calendar year of their 14th birthday) or C+ Squad (entry level for riders joining BD Youth in the year of their 15th birthday) and progress your way through to reach the A Squad. Instead of looking at traditional dressage movements, Youth riders are assessed on the difference you make to your horse and your level of understanding. Every rider has an equal chance to excel!



All riders are required to have had a Formal Squad Assessment if they wish to apply for regional team selection and/or apply for the Foundation Academies. The Inter Regionals team competition is a competition specifically for squad riders. Selection for the Inter Regionals team competition is based on rider skills test marks, where there is more of a focus on the rider's position and effectiveness within a competitive environment.

THE SQUADS

There are three squads in which riders are placed according to their age. D, C and C+, all riders are required to attend a Formal Squad Assessment every year, but riders only need to be considered for squad upgrade if:


1. They are in C+ Squad, and are performing above that level

2. They won at the Youth Inter-Regionals so must move up a squad level.

There is no lower age limit on any of the squads and it is rare for a rider to have the experience and understanding for a squad higher than their entry squad, moving into a new squad before you are ready could put you at a disadvantage when contesting team places and other opportunities.

There is a Formal Squad Assessment/Evaluation Record for each Squad that will provide you and your parents with feedback from the coach/assessor to show you how you can develop further. Each squad has set criteria and you will be identified as 'Emerging', 'Developing', or 'Performing' in each area, this will inform whether you are recommended to upgrade.

- If any area on the criteria is **emerging**, you shouldn't move up a squad unless your age requires it.
- If you are **developing** in all areas, you are probably mid-range of your current squad, and will be encouraged to work towards performing in all areas.
- If you are **performing** in all areas, you will be top end of the squad and possibly nearing the time to move up a squad.



FORMAL SQUAD ASSESSMENT

The Formal Squad Assessments run from 1 December through to Inter-Regional cut-off date of the following year, where riders will be assigned to the appropriate BD Youth squad.

An in-person Formal Squad Assessment will be a coaching session, with no requirement to ride through either a dressage test or a Youth Rider Skills Test. The session will last around 30 minutes for a private session, or 45 minutes for a semi-private – with an additional 5 minutes allowed for a debrief at the end.

An online Formal Squad Assessment will require the rider to submit a video of the combination's training and take part in a short discussion with a Youth Assessor, online. More information about online assessments is available on the Remote Squad Assessment Guidance document.

SQUAD EVALUATION

The squad evaluation sheets are an ongoing training tool to monitor development and encourage a youth member to move up through the squad levels, a Squad Evaluation may be done at any time during the calendar year.

The sessions will be interactive and fun – just like other BD Youth activities!
