

The aim of the Foundation Academy programme is to develop the training and education of BD Youth riders along a defined pathway towards the National Academy and Podium Potential Pathway programmes. Foundation Academies will comprise of two 2-day camps running at several locations across the UK. In order to accept a place as a Foundation Academy Athlete, riders **must be able to** commit to attending both camp dates at the location to which they have been assigned.

Riders should indicate their 1st & 2nd choice of Academy locations. Applicants who are successful will be assigned to their first choice where possible, where capacity means that it is not possible to offer an applicant's first choice, offers will be made based on distance from applicant's home addresses.

### **Foundation Academy Criteria**

- Applicants must have attended 3 regional training sessions between 31 July 2023 1 August 2024. One training session may have been completed online or unmounted, any residential camps will be counted as two sessions.
- Applicants must be in B, B+ or A Squad, having completed a Formal Squad Assessment between 1
  December 2023 and 22 May 2024. Formal Assessments can be completed either online or inperson.
- Applicants must have completed the online modules of the British Dressage Introductory Horse Care Certificate or hold equivalent qualifications which grant direct entry.
- Minimum performance requirement for competition results at BD affiliated shows is three scores of 66% at Elementary level. Applications are encouraged from riders who have competed above this level. All applicants should send in their best three competition results at the level at which they regularly compete. These results should be with the horse/pony on which they wish to participate.
- British Dressage reserves the right to prioritise applications from riders demonstrating consistent competition performance and results indicating an upwards trajectory. Achievement of the minimum performance standards does not guarantee selection. Competition records other than the three submitted scores may be considered in the selection procedure.
- Applications will be considered from riders on young horses (aged 7 years or below) who demonstrate the potential to achieve at least the minimum performance criteria and are achieving consistent scores of a minimum of 66% at the level appropriate for the horse's age and development stage.
- Applicants to submit their best three affiliated competition results gained between 31 July 2023 1 August 2024.
- Results should be from a minimum of two different venues and two different judges.
- Combinations will be selected by a panel of independent members of the BD Youth Technical Committee, references may be requested from Development Officers/Regional Youth Representatives in the process of selecting Foundation Academy Athletes.
- Successful applicants will be contacted before the end of the week commencing 19 August 2024 by email from British Dressage Head Office.



### **Terms and Conditions**

- Full payment of £280 per 2-day camp (£560 per Foundation Academy) will be due 28 days prior to the start date of each camp. (This amount is inclusive of costs for training, stabling and rider catering).
- Cancellations received no less than 14 days prior to a Camp will be refunded minus a 10% admin fee.
- Cancellations made less than 14 days prior to a camp are non-refundable/transferable unless the place can be filled, in which case a full refund (less a 10% admin fee) may be given.
- Amendments to bookings in the 7 days prior to the event are non-refundable and changes are subject to the organisers' discretion.
- Riders who are accepted onto the programme and subsequently change horses between the point
  of application and the first camp, for reasons such as injury, change in FEI age category or
  outgrown pony, may be permitted to attend the camps with the alternative horse following
  assessment of individual circumstances. Combination changes will be subject to the alternative
  horse demonstrating an ability to achieve the minimum performance criteria. Decisions will be at the
  discretion of the BD Youth Technical Committee and priority will be given to combinations already
  achieving minimum performance criteria.

### **Further Information**

- Foundation Academies are partially funded for all athletes and the remaining fee paid by the athlete includes stabling for two nights, one bale of bedding, catering for the athlete and all mounted and unmounted training sessions for the duration of each camp. Additional payment will be required for any required hook-up, additional bedding, and catering for any accompanying parties.
- Venue facilities may vary and therefore any bedding, hook-up and stabling offered may differ depending on the venue.
- Academy clothing will be available to purchase prior to the camps. It is not compulsory for athletes
  to purchase clothing to wear at the camps and smart training clothing is acceptable for coaching
  sessions.
- Athletes are expected to attend and participate in all timetabled activities, non-attendance may affect selection to National Academy. In case of injury, alternative training sessions may be offered at the organiser's discretion.
- All Foundation Academy athletes who have completed all training sessions will be automatically eligible for National Academy selection following completion of all camps. Selection will be based on overall performance, trainability, commitment, and development throughout the duration of the Foundation Academy.
- Athletes may complete a total of three cycles of the BD Youth Academy (Foundation/National Academy). These do not have to be consecutive and athletes will be required to meet the relevant criteria and re-apply each year. This is not affected by National Academy selection.
