FEI Level

Silver PSG/INT I
Horses with any number of points at PSG and above, excluding horses that have obtained 65% or above at a national or international INT2 or GP competition in the current or preceding year.

Gold PSG & Inter I
- Horses with any number of points at PSG and above including horses that have competed internationally.
- Open to riders of any group.

Gold Inter II & Grand Prix
- Direct qualification to National Championships through Premier Leagues or wild card allocation.

Rider to achieve 62% at Advanced 102 or 105 to qualify for PSG level

Adv. Medium

Bronze Advanced Medium
- Neither horse nor rider to have competed at INT 1 or above.
- Horses with up to 50 points at Advanced Medium.
- Combinations that have not scored 63% or above five times at Advanced Medium may remain in Bronze if 50 points are exceeded.

Silver Advanced Medium
- Horses with up to 100 points at Advanced Medium or max of 25 points at higher levels.
- Combinations that have **not** scored 64% or above five times at Advanced Medium may remain in Silver if the above point limits are exceeded.

Gold Advanced Medium
- Horses with any points at Advanced Medium level and any number of points at the levels above.
- Open to riders of any group.
- Combination not to have competed at a Gold (open) Regional at INT1 level or above.

Medium

Bronze Medium
- Neither horse nor rider to have competed at PSG or above
- Neither horse nor rider to have won more than 15 points at Advanced Medium level or above.
- Horses with up to 50 points at Medium.
- Combinations that have not scored 63% or above five times at Medium may remain in Bronze if 50 points are exceeded.

Silver Medium
- Horses with up to 100 points at Medium or max of 25 points at higher levels.
- Combinations that have **not** scored 64% or above five times at Medium may remain in Silver if the above point limits are exceeded.

Gold Medium
- Horses with any points at Medium level and any number of points at the levels above.
- Open to riders of any group.
- Combination not to have competed at a Gold (open) Regional at PSG level or above.

Elementary

Bronze Elementary
- Neither horse nor rider to have competed at Advanced Medium or above
- Neither horse nor rider to have won more than 15 points at Medium level or above.
- Horses with up to 50 points at Elementary.
- Combinations that have not scored 64% or above five times at Elementary may remain in Bronze if 50 points are exceeded.

Silver Elementary
- Horses with up to 100 points at Elementary or max of 25 points at higher levels.
- Combinations that have **not** scored 66% or above five times at Elementary may remain in Silver if the above point limits are exceeded.

Gold Elementary
- Horses with any points at Elementary level and any number of points at the levels above.
- Open to riders of any group.
- Combination not to have competed at a Gold (open) Regional at Adv. Medium level or above.

Novice

Bronze Novice
- Neither horse nor rider to have competed at Medium or above.
- Neither horse nor rider to have won more than 15 points at Elementary level or above.
- Horses with up to 50 points at Novice.
- Combinations that have not scored 66% or above five times at Novice may remain in Bronze if 50 points are exceeded.

Silver Novice
- Horses with up to 100 points at Novice or max of 25 points at higher levels.
- Combinations that have **not** scored 67% or above five times at Novice may remain in Silver if the above point limits are exceeded.

Gold Novice
- Horses with any points at Novice level and any number of points at the levels above.
- Open to riders of any group.
- Combination not to have competed at a Gold (open) Regional at Medium level or above.

Preliminary

Bronze Preliminary
- Neither horse nor rider to have competed at Elementary or above.
- Neither horse nor rider to have won more than 15 points at Novice level or above.
- Horses with up to 50 points at Prelim.
- Combinations that have not scored 66% or above five times at Prelim may remain in Bronze if 50 points are exceeded.

Silver Preliminary
- Rider not to have competed at Elementary or above.
- Horses with up to 100 points at Prelim or max of 25 points at higher levels.
- Combinations that have **not** scored 66% or above five times at Prelim. may remain in Silver if the above point limits are exceeded.

Gold Preliminary
- Horses with any points at Prelim and any number of points at the levels above.
- Open to riders of any group.
- Combination not to have competed at a Gold (open) Regional at Elementary level or above
