## BEF PARA EQUESTRIAN ENTRY PROGRAMME CRITERIA

The aim of this initiative is to encourage young riders to make the next steps towards competing in British Dressage Para-Equestrian competition and entry onto the talent pathway. This programme will assist these riders to move onto the more advanced talent pathway schemes ready for the BEF Excel Talent Programme.

The criterion to be eligible to apply to ride on these days is:

- Hold a National classification within the 5 Grades eligible to compete in British Dressage Para Equestrian competition \*
- Be currently scoring 60% or above in their relevant grade at RDA qualifiers for the RDA National Championships.

Your Application will fall under one of the following Age groups:

- Group 1 – Riders between 10-14yrs
- Group 2 – Riders between 15-20yrs
- Group 3 – Riders 20yrs and above

**Please send a copy of your classification letter from the RDA together with your completed application form.**

### ***\*Riders with Learning Disabilities:***

*Currently under Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) rules, a rider with intellectual disabilities, who does not have a physical classification, is covered under Profile 39 of the Classification Guide (applicable to Grade III). This profile remains inactive at present so riders in Profile 39 are currently not eligible to compete in Para Equestrian competition run under BD & FEI rules. This policy will reviewed in line with any future decisions made by the F.E.I.*
