



# RULES FOR SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFIERS 2018

- a) Qualifiers for the Scottish Championships will run from 1 September of the previous year up to the close of entries for the Championships.
- b) Horses that finish 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in each Scottish Championship Qualifying class in Scotland or elsewhere in Great Britain if ridden by a resident in Scotland or a person born there will qualify. All affiliated classes at BD competitions held in the qualifying period are qualifiers (classes are deemed to be affiliated when grading points are associated with the class).
- c) Qualifying percentages:
- Prelim - 65% or above
  - Novice - 65% or above
  - Elementary - 63% or above
  - Medium - 62% or above
  - Advanced Medium - 60% or above
  - PSG - 60% or above
  - Inter I - 60% or above

#### Freestyle to Music

- Novice - 66% or above
  - Elementary - 65% or above
  - Medium - 63% or above
  - Advanced Medium - 62% or above
  - PSG - 62% or above
- d) Once a member has achieved the required qualification, they must download and complete a qualification registration form from the Scotland page of the BD website and email this to [emma.stewart@britishdressage.co.uk](mailto:emma.stewart@britishdressage.co.uk) in order to declare their intent to compete.
- e) In relation to eligibility and upgrading the Scottish Championships are run in accordance with ***Regional Championship Rules***.
- f) Preliminary classes are only open to combinations eligible for Preliminary Bronze or Preliminary Silver.
- g) All horses and riders must be fully registered with BD to compete at the Scottish Championships.
