Rider Squad Tests:

The rider tests have been designed to show the assessor(s) how well a rider can influence their horses way of going through a supple and correct seat, good preparation, and a good a relationship with their horse.

The tests are marked out of a score of 100, which is distributed across 3 sections – it is important to remember that this score is not equivalent to a dressage test percentage mark.

Rules:

The Scottish BYRDS Championship Trophy Show will be run under British Dressage rules with BD listed judges. This competition is an associated competition of BD and therefore results will not be listed on the horse or riders record and grading points will not be awarded. Test sheets from this competition cannot be used for qualification for Area Festivals or Regional Championships or BYRDS team selection.

Prizes:

Trophies will be awarded to the leading rider of the competition at Fledglings, C squad, B squad and A squad levels. Points will be awarded for placings in each class with the trophies being awarded to the rider with the highest total points (the highest points from a maximum of three classes will be used). Riders will have to compete in the squad tests in order to be eligible to be awarded the rider squad trophies. Riders may only compete at one squad level. Riders must be a paid member of BD to be eligible to win a points trophy.
