



REGIONAL TEAM OPPORTUNITES

SENIOR INTER REGIONAL COMPETITION

The College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe

11 – 12 May 2019

Eligibility:

- Open to riders over the age of 18 years, as of the 1st January 2019, who are **FULL** members of British Dressage.
- Each team will comprise of four riders from Prelim up to Medium at Bronze and Silver levels.
- This is a grassroots competition and is ideal for those who have recently joined British Dressage, those who have not yet been on a regional team, and those who have participated in Area Festivals and Regional Championships. This is very much a restricted competition.
- Open to both able bodied and Para Dressage riders.
- Riders and Horses who have competed at Area Festivals, Area Festival Championships and Regional Championships **ARE** eligible to participate.
- Riders and Horses who have competed in the National Championships or Winter Championships (including Music classes) in the previous 12 months are **NOT** eligible to participate.
- Riders who intend to compete in the BD Youth team competitions in the same calendar year, may **NOT** also take part in this competition.

Requirements:

- Riders will be asked to submit their highest four scores at affiliated dressage competitions in the 12 months preceding selection. At least two of which are to be within 6 months of the deadline for submission of scores and at least two scores must be from qualifier tests. These can include sheets from the Home International / Inter Regionals in previous 12 months.
- Attendance at three regional training events (can include Flexi Training) in the 12 month period preceding the final selection date.
- Teams will be selected in accordance with the Regional Selection Policy and BD Rules 2019.
- Eligibility as per the table below:

| Level | Eligibility New Structure |
|------------|-------------------------------|
| Prelim | Bronze or Silver combinations |
| Novice | Bronze or Silver combinations |
| Elementary | Bronze or Silver combinations |
| Medium | Bronze or Silver combinations |
