Class 1 and 4 will be run as one with all grades competing against each other. The top 10 placing will be determined by highest overall % scores irrespective of Grade.

Eligibility

Riders must be profiled with a physical classification and classified Grade I –V under FEI/BD Rules and must compete in the Grade Class that they are Classified (Grade I – V).

The competition is restricted to BD Para Group E riders or those new to the sport (please see page 82 of BD rule book).

This class is open to riders who are eligible to compete in the RDA walk, trot and canter test 31 (2002) at RDA dressage competitions. It is a requirement that riders must be members of an RDA centre and this must be clearly stated on the entry form. This competition will be run under RDA Dressage rules.

Qualifying Classes

Class 1a – 1e is a qualifying class for the Para Equestrian Bronze Intro Championship. To qualify for the Bronze Intro Championship, combinations must obtain an average score of

66% or more in a minimum of two Para Bronze qualifiers between 1st August 2016 and 31st July 2017.

To be eligible for the Intro Show Championship riders must be BD CLUB members & associate horse registration.

Riders will be able to ride the same intro test twice in a day by entering two classes. This helps with trying to gain qualification for the Bronze Intro Championship.

Class 3 is a qualifying class for the Para Equestrian Silver Summer Championships.
